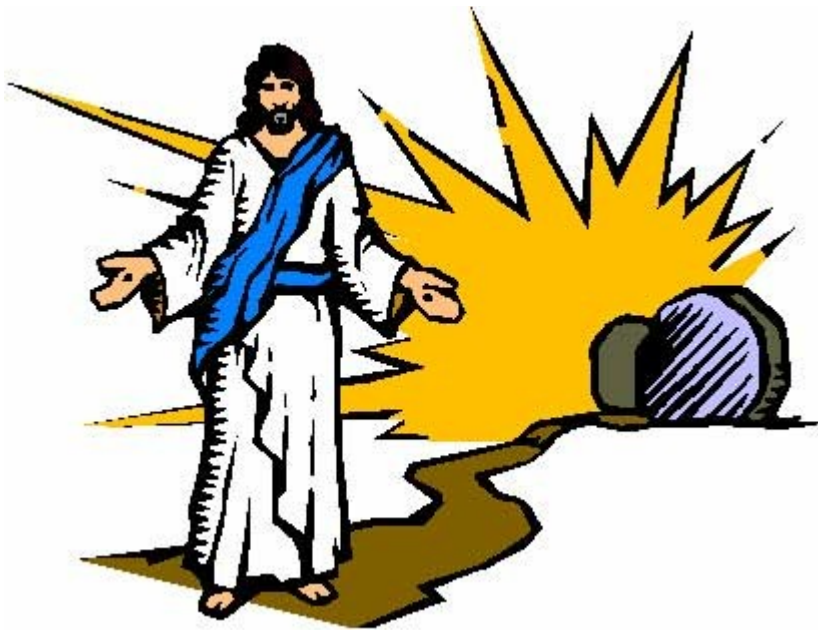


Prayer Requests This Week
